A special feature of the Great Western Academy curriculum is that we offer a selection of option subjects which students study in Year 9. Why?



This gives students the opportunity to try subjects which they might want to opt for at GCSE and to spend more time doing subjects that they enjoy and find interesting.

It also gives them experience of making good choices so that they are better placed to make well informed decisions when they choose their GCSE subjects next year.



Y9 Curriculum at GWA

In Year 9 the curriculum is still made up from the same core subjects alongside 5 optional subjects*.

PSHE

Combined Science

- Covers all of the program of study in biology, chemistry and physics
- Less content and shorter exams
- Accepted by all post-16 providers to access Alevel science courses (Grade 6-6 minimum requirement)

Separate Sciences

- Provides greater depth and greater challenge
- More content and longer exams
- The corresponding subject at grade 6 required as a minimum for A-level courses
- If you are in X1/X2/Y1/Y2, you will start the separate Science GCSE course.
- If you are in X3 or Y3, you will start on the combined Science course.

In both cases, this is so you can access the learning at an appropriate pace and level of challenge, helping you to achieve the best GCSE outcomes possible.

- Talk decisions through with your child, but encourage them to make the decision themselves
- Encourage your child to think carefully about what subjects they want to continue with
- Encourage your child to talk to their teachers about what they will study in Year 9 in their subject and how it might help them in the future
- Be ready to make choices over the half-term break

- Encourage your child not to just do what their friends are doing!
- Ignore the need to make a decision otherwise the decision will be made for each student
- Do it alone talk to people around you and have a think about what the consequences of each decision (good and bad) might be
- Forget... we are here to help you!


How Do I Make My Choices?

Year 8 Curriculum Choices

Our curriculum ethos remains the same in Year 9 as it is through Years 7 and 8. We offer:

- · a broad and balanced curriculum designed to engage and challenge students;
- an ambitious and aspirational curriculum understanding the importance of achieving the best qualifications to maximise chances of success beyond school;
- diverse and coherent curriculum choices, developing the knowledge, skills and understanding through study that will remain with students long after examinations.

In Y9 most of the curriculum is still made up from familiar core subjects: English, maths, science, a language, geography, history, DT, PE, philosophy and religion and PSHE.

However, for the remaining 5 lessons each week, Year 9 students can choose from a small range of options in art, dance, drama, music, business studies, computing, PE theory and a second language.
